- 15 support their work in civic engagement of Franklin
- 16 County's youth and children, working primarily in
- 17 the areas of civics education, curriculum
- 18 development, and presentations in classrooms, and
- 19 also mock elections.
- 20 Several years ago, almost three years
- 21 ago now, with the generosity of the county
- 22 commissioners, we have increased that grant from
- 23 20,000 to 25,000, so this would be the motion for
- 24 the 2011 annual grant to Kids Voting.

- 22 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: I'll add to that
- 23 similar sentiments. You held this place together
- 24 through thick and thin and led a team, but with

- 1 great example, in terms of personal industry and
- 2 integrity and foresight.
- 3 You've done a great job for the voters
- 4 and the citizens, for the party, for both parties.
- 5 You've been a fierce competitor, but an honorable
- 6 opponent, I think, for our -- for the folks, our
- 7 friends across the aisle, and so we salute you for
- 8 that and wish you the best in your growing and
- 9 expanding career, because that's what's happening.
- 10 You leave some big shoes to fill, and
- 11 appreciate your commitment to this institution and
- 12 the continued commitment to the elections system
- 13 and democracy here in the state. You're just
- 14 taking a big role. Now you have 88 counties to
- 15 look after, so congratulations.
- MR. DAMSCHRODER: Thank you.
- 17 It's been a great opportunity and a
- 18 great experience that I have loved and enjoyed. A
- 19 lot has happened. I've learned a lot, I've made a
- lot of good decisions, I've made a lot of stupid
- 21 decisions that I learned from.
- 22 And I'm very grateful to Michael and
- 23 Carolyn and Denny and Bill when they first hired
- 24 me in June of '03. And the Board has stuck with

- 1 me and allowed me to grow and spread my wings as a
- 2 public administrator, and I've made a lot of
- 3 friends and learned a lot of good lessons.
- 4 And it is with a great deal of both
- 5 sadness, but also excitement that I leave for this
- 6 next phase in my life. So I thank you and look
- 7 forward to continuing to work with you.
