Proceedings before Chairman Douglas J. Preisse,
Director William A. Anthony, Jr., Deputy Director

at Franklin County Board of Elections, 280 East Broad
Street, Room 100, Columbus, Ohio on Saturday, November
19, 2011, at 10:01 o'clock a.m.

1. PROCEEDINGS 2 3 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: I'd like to call the Franklin County Board of Elections meeting to order. 5 Roll call. 6 Kimberly Marinello? MS. MARINELLO: Here. DIRECTOR ANTHONY: Zachary Manifold? 9 MR. MANIFOLD: Here. 10 11 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: Douglas Preisse? 12 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Here. 13 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: Michael Colley? MR. COLLEY: Here. 14 15 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: All counted for, Mr. Chairman. 16 First item on the business is to review --17 18 we've got about six ballots that we would like for you guys to take a look at for the signatures, and so 19 20 we'll bring them in and have you guys one at a time take a look at them and see what you all think about 21 22 them. MS. KLCO: This is on the registration and 23

this is how they signed the provisional on each one,

- 1 if you want to take a look at those and tell me what
- 2 you think.
- 3 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: And so these six are in
- 4 question here because of the --
- 5 MS. KLCO: Signature doesn't match at all.
- 6 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: -- anomaly between here
- 7 and here, this being a xerox copy of the registration.
- 8 DEPUTY DIRECTOR BURD: Bill and I reviewed
- 9 these, I think, two days ago, and we were of the
- 10 mind-set that we would recommend to reject all of
- 11 these because we don't think the signatures match at
- 12 all, but we wanted to bring them to your attention so
- 13 that you could let us know if you had any different
- 14 thoughts on it.
- 15 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Why don't I give them to
- 16 you and then we can pass them down, if everybody wants
- 17 to look at them. We're comparing to this.
- DIRECTOR ANTHONY: You want to do them one
- 19 at a time, or do you want to look at all of them and
- 20 then do them?
- 21 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Well, I guess we could do
- 22 that. I think that makes sense. Yeah, let's look at
- 23 them one at a time. You saw that one. I saw it.
- 24 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: So this first one was

- MS. MARINELLO: Antoinette Horton.
- 3 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: Antoinette Corton?
- 4 MS. MARINELLO: Horton.
- 5 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: H-o -- spell it for me.
- 6 MS. MARINELLO: Like Horton Hears a Who,
- $7 \quad H-o-r-t-o-n.$
- 8 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: Okay. What's the will of
- 9 the Board? Has everybody seen this one? What's the
- 10 will of the Board on this one? Does it match?
- MR. MANIFOLD: I don't think it matches.
- DIRECTOR ANTHONY: So how do we do that? So
- 13 all those -- how would we do that?
- 14 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: What's our -- we -- do we
- 15 have to make a motion?
- 16 DEPUTY DIRECTOR BURD: We were going to
- 17 make -- what we were going to do is have you review
- 18 them all and then just make a motion to reject them
- 19 all, if you agreed with our assessment they should be
- 20 rejected. If you didn't agree with that, then we
- 21 could do it one by one.
- CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Why don't we do that, and
- 23 then if any board member wishes to pull one out --
- DEPUTY DIRECTOR BURD: We can handle that.

1 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: -- for separate
```

- 2 consideration. Does that make sense?
- 3 MS. MARINELLO: Yeah.
- 4 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: And then we just lump
- 5 them in, all the ones that are rejected then?
- 6 DEPUTY DIRECTOR BURD: Uh-huh.
- 7 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: All right. I just made
- 8 it complicated; didn't I?
- 9 MS. MARINELLO: You tried.
- MR. COLLEY: Where does this go?
- DEPUTY DIRECTOR BURD: Down to Zack and Kim.
- 12 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: There was six of those;
- 13 right?
- MS. MARINELLO: Uh-huh.
- DIRECTOR ANTHONY: Okay.
- 16 (Board members reviewing documents.)
- DIRECTOR ANTHONY: That was that.
- 18 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Yeah. Any member of the
- 19 Board want to comment on those six that we just
- 20 reviewed?
- MS. MARINELLO: They were pretty clearly --
- 22 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: I concur that there's
- 23 great differences between the signatures in each of
- 24 those.

- 1 MR. MANIFOLD: I agree.
- 2 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: So do you do a motion,
- 3 then, for those, or do we lump them all up into --
- 4 DEPUTY DIRECTOR BURD: The second motion for
- 5 the total numbers includes -- is prepared as if we
- 6 were going to reject those six, so we can make a
- 7 motion to reject those six --
- 8 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: Okay.
- 9 DEPUTY DIRECTOR BURD: -- and then the
- 10 second motion will stay the same.
- DIRECTOR ANTHONY: All right. We'll
- 12 entertain that motion if anyone wants to make it.
- MR. MANIFOLD: Mr. Chairman, I move that the
- 14 board reject as invalid the six ballots reviewed for
- 15 having non-genuine signatures.
- MR. COLLEY: Second.
- 17 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: All those in favor, say
- 18 aye.
- 19 THE BOARD: Aye.
- 20 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: Then the rest of them I
- 21 could -- we probably should have Renee come up and go
- 22 through the columns and say why they were not accepted
- 23 as ballots.
- 24 Did we take a vote?

- DEPUTY DIRECTOR BURD: Yeah, we did.
- 2 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: Oh, okay.
- 3 MS. KLCO: We had 548 ballots where the
- 4 voter was not registered anywhere in Ohio; 349 where
- 5 the voter voted in the wrong precinct; 66 voters
- 6 failed to provide any identification; 24 did not sign
- 7 the form; 46 did not print their name on the form,
- 8 which is a requirement; and 19 voted absentee, 15 of
- 9 them had incomplete forms that we couldn't process at
- 10 all.
- 11 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: You skipped that six
- 12 number, but just --
- MS. KLCO: And we just went over the six.
- 14 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Those were the ones we
- 15 just rejected --
- MS. KLCO: Yes.
- 17 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: -- where we voted on
- 18 non-matching; right?
- 19 MS. KLCO: Correct.
- 20 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: So we minus that six out
- 21 at 1,058?
- DEPUTY DIRECTOR BURD: No, I think that we
- 23 would keep it in, because this motion was just the
- 24 total.

- 1 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: Okay.
- DEPUTY DIRECTOR BURD: I think the first
- 3 motion was just to solidify that the Board looked at
- 4 those and agreed that they should be rejected. And
- 5 then I think that it's okay to keep them in the total
- 6 number of rejected ballots for our final motion.
- 7 That's my take on it.
- 8 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: All right. That's fine.
- 9 And how many times do you go over these?
- MS. KLCO: Two to three times.
- 11 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: Okay. And we also -- on
- 12 the ones that we had in question, we reached out to
- 13 the Secretary of State's Office and got an opinion on
- 14 all of them before we ended up not accepting them.
- 15 DEPUTY DIRECTOR BURD: Yeah, we had, I
- 16 think, six categories that we wanted clarification on,
- 17 and we have written documentation on the response from
- 18 the legal counsel in the Secretary of State's Office
- 19 on all of those, so we feel pretty good that we had
- 20 clarification on everything.
- 21 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: So we feel pretty
- 22 confident we counted everything that we can legally
- 23 count; and that those that we can't, we cannot legally
- 24 count them.

- 1 DEPUTY DIRECTOR BURD: This would be a
- 2 validity rate of 89.7 percent. Just for comparison,
- 3 last year it was 91 percent, so it's fairly consistent
- 4 with what we saw last year in terms of the number we
- 5 were able to count -- or the percentage we were able
- 6 to count.
- 7 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: Any questions of Renee?
- 8 Any other ones you guys need to ask?
- 9 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Not for me.
- MS. MARINELLO: Not for me.
- 11 Mr. Chairman, I move that the Board accept
- 12 the staff recommendation for the validation of 9,232
- 13 and rejection of 1,058 provisional ballots as
- 14 submitted.
- DIRECTOR ANTHONY: Is there a second?
- MR. COLLEY: Second.
- 17 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: All those in favor, say
- 18 aye.
- 19 THE BOARD: Aye.
- DIRECTOR ANTHONY: All right. That's all we
- 21 had to do today. Tomorrow --
- DEPUTY DIRECTOR BURD: Yeah, I was going to
- 23 say, we'll be opening these ballots on Monday and then
- 24 the remaining absentees are still to be opened and
