May 22, 2015.

DIRECTOR ANTHONY: I'm going to call the Franklin County Board of Elections meeting to order, our special meeting.

Roll call. Kimberly Marinello.

MEMBER MARINELLO: Here.

DIRECTOR ANTHONY: Doug Preisse.

CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Here.

DIRECTOR ANTHONY: Bradley Sinnott.

MEMBER SINNOTT: Here.

DIRECTOR ANTHONY: Mr. Chairman, we have a quorum. The first item on the agenda is the election day write-in. I guess there was a voter intent situation, Jeff?

MR. MACKEY: We wanted to put the question before the Board. On the voting machines there were three voters, and there's an exhibit in front of you, who instead of voting for the actual candidate that was listed for Mayor of Columbus, they went down to the write-in box, selected the write-in option and then typed in the name of one of the candidates that is listed there. So you can see

1 there that we had two for Terry Boyd and one for
2 Scott which we are giving credit for Zach Scott since
3 there was only one person with the first or last name
4 on the ballot.

5 We wanted to make sure that was okay with
6 you guys.

7 MEMBER SINNOTT: Jeff, so what you are
8 proposing to do is include in the official canvass
9 two votes for Terry Boyd because the voter wrote in
10 Terry Boyd, one vote for Zach Scott because the voter
11 wrote in Scott, and then you would not count at all
12 the vote for Dr. Who.

13 MR. MACKEY: That is correct. Dr. Who
14 was neither a certified write-in candidate nor a
15 certified candidate to the regular ballot.

16 MEMBER MARINELLO: He can try again next
17 time.

18 MR. MACKEY: I understand you did a
19 similar operation to this on the paper ballot for
20 absentee on Monday for the voter skipped over the
21 actual names of the candidates, chose the write-in
22 box, and then wrote in the name of the candidate.

23 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: That was for
24 Columbus City Council?

1 MR. MACKEY: Right. That was for the
2 Columbus City Council.

3 MEMBER MARINELLO: I don't see any
4 problem with that. I move the Board accept the
5 voters' intent and that the three ballots shall be
6 included in the official canvass.

7 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: Is there a second?

8 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Second.

9 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: All those in favor.

10 The motion carries.

11 MR. MACKEY: In anticipation of you doing
12 that, the report in front of you includes those three
13 votes, two for Terry Boyd, one for Zach Scott in the
14 official canvass, giving you both a summary report
15 and one that splits out the details.

16 MEMBER SINNOTT: So this document is a
17 summary of that document?

18 MR. MACKEY: Correct. Group detail just
19 shows how -- the different buckets that the votes
20 were in, absentee, in-person absentee, election day.

21 MEMBER SINNOTT: I move that the Board
22 certify and declare as final the official canvass of
23 votes cast at the May 5, 2015, primary election as
24 submitted by staff.

1 MEMBER MARINELLO: Second.

2 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: Is there a second?

3 All those in favor.

4 That motion carries.

5 MR. MACKEY: I have for everyone the
6 official certification form as followed by the most
7 populous certification forms which I will complete
8 when we have official certification from Licking and
9 Delaware Counties.

10 MEMBER SINNOTT: So what you want us to
11 do is now sign the official canvass.

12 MR. MACKEY: Correct, please. And then
13 if you could sign each form behind that, that would
14 be fantastic, official certifications of the most
15 populous.

16 MEMBER SINNOTT: All right.

17 MR. MACKEY: There are a number of those.

18 MEMBER SINNOTT: You could probably
19 continue while we work.

20 MR. MACKEY: While you are working on
21 this since you have certified the election now, the
22 Board of Education in Columbus, member of the Board
23 of Education, the difference between the eighth place
24 finisher of the top eight that are nominated and the

1 first declared defeated candidate Brian Bainbridge,
2 the difference there is 76 votes, and the difference
3 required for an automatic recount to be ordered is at
4 106 votes, so the difference being 76 falls within
5 the 1/2 of 1 percent to require an automatic recount
6 for the Columbus Board of Education race.

7 MEMBER SINNOTT: I move that the Board
8 set a recount for the Columbus City School District
9 board member to begin Wednesday, May 27, at 9 a.m. at
10 1700 Morse Road until completed and that the recount
11 be conducted in accordance with Secretary of State
12 Directive 2014-13.

13 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: Is there a second?

14 MEMBER MARINELLO: Second.

15 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: All those in favor.
16 That motion carries.

17 MR. MACKEY: Per Secretary of State
18 Directive 2014-13, at any time after an automatic
19 recount is ordered, which we just did, before the
20 automatic recount commences the declared defeated
21 candidate may file a written request to stop the
22 recount.

23 MEMBER SINNOTT: And, Mr. Chairman, I can
24 report that yesterday afternoon Brian Bainbridge

1 delivered to my law office a letter addressed to you,
2 I told him I would carry it to the Board today, which
3 reads "Chairman Price, as the declared defeated
4 candidate in the May 5, 2015, primary election for
5 member of Board of Education Columbus City School
6 District, I, Brian C. Bainbridge, request the Board
7 stop the recount for said election. Regards, Brian
8 Bainbridge."

9 I had an opportunity to speak to
10 Mr. Bainbridge this week, and he said that he was
11 sensitive to the needs of the taxpayers of Franklin
12 County and would not want a recount to take place
13 under this circumstance. He thought he was doing the
14 voters and taxpayers a service by asking that no
15 recount take place; I believe the explanation for the
16 letter.

17 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Sounds sufficient to
18 me.

19 MEMBER MARINELLO: I move the Board
20 accept the recount waiver letter as submitted by
21 Brian C. Bainbridge in which he asks to forgo the
22 automatic recount.

23 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: Is there a second?

24 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Second.

1 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: All those in favor.

2 Thank you, Mr. Bainbridge.

3 MR. MACKEY: Yes. One final little note,
 4 I wanted to mention Fairfield County did complete
 5 their official canvass yesterday. They had two
 6 provisional ballots that were outstanding in
 7 Columbus, and when they counted those, Terry Boyd and
 8 Zach Scott each picked up one vote apiece, so the
 9 difference remained unchanged as far as any potential
 10 recount in that race.

11 MEMBER SINNOTT: Have we heard from
 12 Delaware?

13 MR. MACKEY: Not yet.

14 MEMBER SINNOTT: Would somebody go up
 15 there and find out what Delaware is doing?

16 MR. MACKEY: They intend to certify on
 17 Tuesday.

18 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: That's all before the
 19 Board for this meeting. Is there a motion for
 20 adjournment?

21 MEMBER SINNOTT: There is.

22 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: Is there a second?

23 MEMBER MARINELLO: Second.

24 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: We stand adjourned.


