1 Monday Afternoon Session,  
2 October 2, 2017.

3 - - -

4 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Looks like we're  
5 all accounted for, but we'll take attendance.

6 Kim Marinello.

7 MEMBER MARINELLO: Here.

8 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Mike Sexton.

9 MEMBER SEXTON: Here.

10 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Doug Preisse.

11 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Here.

12 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: And Brad Sinnott.

13 MEMBER SINNOTT: Yes.

14 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: We have a quorum.

15 I think we just got the minutes from the  
16 last meeting. And I believe you brought them in with  
17 you; thank you very much.

18 If you care to view those, we have those,  
19 Suzanne; is that right?

20 MS. BROWN: Yes.

21 MEMBER MARINELLO: I think we got them  
22 e-mailed to us.

23 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Oh, you did get  
24 them e-mailed to you?

25 MEMBER MARINELLO: Yeah.

1 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Okay. Fantastic.

2 MEMBER MARINELLO: I move that the Board  
3 approve the minutes of the September 11th, 2017  
4 meeting of the Franklin County Board of Elections as  
5 submitted.

6 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: I second the motion.

7 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All in favor,  
8 signify by saying aye.

9 (Thereupon, all members voted  
10 affirmatively.)

11 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All opposed, same  
12 sign.

13 (No response.)

14 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Motion carries.

15 We are required to approve our paper  
16 ballot allocation as well as our voting machine  
17 allocation and e-pollbook allocation two times. So  
18 if Carolyn is here, we've already done that at the  
19 last meeting, but there are a few changes at least in  
20 the --

21 MS. GORUP: Paper ballots.

22 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: -- paper ballots.

23 MS. GORUP: So which one are we doing  
24 first?

25 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Let's do the

1 paper ballot allocation first.

2 MS. GORUP: When we did the paper ballot  
3 allocation last month, we didn't have the locations  
4 where the ballot styles were the same and so we could  
5 combine those precincts, precinct splits, and do less  
6 provisional ballots, so there has been a change to  
7 the paper ballot allocation.

8 DIRECTOR LEONARD: I take it that the  
9 changes that are made are those that are highlighted  
10 on the Exhibit A?

11 MS. GORUP: The changes -- the ones that  
12 are highlighted were new locations, new precincts  
13 that didn't exist, so we had no history. So those  
14 ones were done based on 2 percent of the active  
15 registration; whereas, the other ones were done based  
16 on previous provisional ballots.

17 MEMBER SINNOTT: All right. I move the  
18 Board adopt the paper ballot allocation formula in  
19 Exhibit A compiled by the Board staff for the  
20 November 7th, 2017 General Election.

21 MEMBER MARINELLO: Second.

22 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Is there a  
23 second?

24 MEMBER MARINELLO: Second.

25 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All those in

1 favor, signify by saying are.

2 (Thereupon, all members voted  
3 affirmatively.)

4 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All opposed, same  
5 sign.

6 (No response.)

7 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Motion carries.  
8 Voting machine allocation and e-pollbook  
9 allocation. I don't think there are any changes.

10 MS. GORUP: There are no changes to that  
11 allocation.

12 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: But let's go  
13 through the process.

14 MS. GORUP: But we are required to  
15 re-approve it.

16 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: No changes since?

17 MS. GORUP: Last month.

18 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: The last meeting  
19 where we approved it the first time.

20 DIRECTOR LEONARD: But again, they're  
21 required to be approved on two separate occasions.

22 MS. GORUP: Right.

23 MEMBER SEXTON: I move that the Board  
24 adopt the voting machine allocation formula in  
25 Exhibit B compiled by the Board staff for the

1 November 7th, 2017 General Election.

2 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Is there a  
3 second?

4 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Second.

5 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All those in  
6 favor, signify by saying aye.

7 (Thereupon, all members voted  
8 affirmatively.)

9 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All opposed, same  
10 sign.

11 (No response.)

12 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Motion carries.

13 The next item of business, we had three  
14 withdrawals of candidates from the November 7th, 2017  
15 General Election ballot. I believe you have copies  
16 of the three letters and/or e-mails that were sent to  
17 Jeff Mackey, asking to be removed from the  
18 consideration of the November 7th, 2017 General  
19 Election ballot. It does -- we are required to  
20 accept the -- or at least vote on the withdrawals.

21 MEMBER MARINELLO: I move that the Board  
22 accept the request for withdrawal from the ballot of  
23 Joe -- Joel Scipio, candidate for Hilliard City  
24 Council, and Adam Slane and Kirk Hamilton, candidates  
25 for South-Western City School District Board of

1 Education, and that their votes not be counted for  
2 the November 7th, 2017 General Election.

3 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Is there a  
4 second?

5 DIRECTOR LEONARD: You'll note from the  
6 -- from the letters that the two South-Western City  
7 School candidates were both write-in candidates for  
8 that particular race. And, I'm sorry, you were  
9 calling for a second.

10 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Second.

11 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All those in  
12 favor, signify by saying aye.

13 (Thereupon, all members voted  
14 affirmatively.)

15 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All opposed, same  
16 sign.

17 (No response.)

18 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Motion carries.

19 The next item is the employee healthcare  
20 insurance contribution rates. And we do have a  
21 recommendation from the County Commissioners to  
22 accept their rates, but we're an entity of our own,  
23 we wouldn't have to do that, but the past practice is  
24 to accept those rates.

25 So, Allison, do you want to --

1 MS. MURRAY: Yeah.

2 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Maybe I already  
3 did your -- stepped on your parade.

4 MS. MURRAY: I have a little bit more.

5 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Okay.

6 MS. MURRAY: All right. So as the Deputy  
7 Director already stated, the Franklin County  
8 Cooperative's 2018 Healthcare Plan begins on  
9 January 1st, 2018. Our agency needs to confirm, with  
10 the county benefits department, the employee  
11 contributions that we will charge effective  
12 January 1st, 2018, through December 31st, 2018.

13 We are not an agency under the Board of  
14 Commissioners, but have always followed the Board of  
15 Commissioners' recommended employee contributions.

16 For the 2018 year, the Board of  
17 Commissioners' approved monthly contribution rates  
18 are as follows:

19 For employee only, as well as employee  
20 plus children, the rate will increase from \$131 a  
21 month to \$136 a month.

22 For employee plus spouse or domestic  
23 partner, as well as employee plus spouse or domestic  
24 partner and children, the rate will increase from  
25 \$278 a month to \$292 a month.

1 We believe we should approve the Board of  
 2 Commissioners' recommended contributions as we have  
 3 always done so in the past.

4 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Thank you.

5 DIRECTOR LEONARD: The Commissioners do  
 6 budget our funding for healthcare benefits based on  
 7 the rates that we're being asked to support.

8 MEMBER SINNOTT: So these are the same  
 9 terms of coverage as other county employees?

10 MS. MURRAY: Yes, yes.

11 MEMBER SINNOTT: I move that the Board  
 12 adopt the monthly employee healthcare insurance  
 13 contribution rates for fiscal year 2018 as  
 14 recommended by the Franklin County Commissioners.  
 15 The new cost will be \$136 for any board member or  
 16 employee and/or the board member's or employee's  
 17 child slash -- child or children, or \$292 for any  
 18 board member or employee that includes a spouse or  
 19 domestic partner.

20 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: We'd be looking  
 21 for a second.

22 MEMBER SEXTON: Second.

23 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All those in  
 24 favor, signify by saying aye.

25 (Thereupon, all members voted

1 affirmatively.)

2 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All opposed, same  
3 sign.

4 (No response.)

5 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Motion carries.

6 The employee time accounting procedure.  
7 We brought that up at our last meeting and there were  
8 some questions and some alterations that the Board  
9 asked for, so we believe that we've incorporated  
10 those.

11 DIRECTOR LEONARD: Yes. I know, Brad,  
12 you had brought up questions with regard to the  
13 mandatory requirement that would -- might result in a  
14 situation where somebody actually did work and they  
15 were not going to be paid for that lunch period if we  
16 were to impose it from a mandatory standpoint.

17 And so we adjusted that language to,  
18 again, that employees must clock out for lunch and  
19 that they're encouraged to take an hour lunch break,  
20 and that whether or not an employee leaves the  
21 building, employees are encouraged to take a minimum  
22 of at least a half-hour, 30-minute lunch break.

23 So it all again gets back to encouraging  
24 people to take a lunch, but not -- if an individual  
25 doesn't, if somebody happens to work through lunch

1 for purposes of -- during periods of peak activity at  
2 the Board of Elections, they're not penalized for  
3 that.

4 And again, we'll be putting it on our  
5 managers to kind of keep an eye on that with staff  
6 that you don't have situations where individuals are  
7 working through their lunch, but -- or, that are  
8 taking their lunch at their desk and not clocking out  
9 and then not deducting it from their time.

10 So if somebody is taking a lunch, we want  
11 to make sure that they're -- that that's being  
12 accounted for in the -- on our records, payroll  
13 records.

14 MEMBER SEXTON: So this is pretty much  
15 permissive rather than mandatory?

16 DIRECTOR LEONARD: Well, no. People are  
17 required to use the time clock. They are required to  
18 check in and out. They can't have somebody else  
19 clock in or out for them; they have to do that  
20 themselves and so -- but when it comes to the lunch  
21 hour, we encourage people to take a lunch if -- and  
22 that they should clock out for lunch. If they're  
23 taking a lunch, they should clock out for lunch, so  
24 that is mandatory that they clock out for lunch.

25 MEMBER SEXTON: If they're taking one.

1           DIRECTOR LEONARD:  If they're taking one.  
2    So again, we may have a situation where somebody,  
3    because of the needs of the operation, they work  
4    through their lunch, that they don't get penalized  
5    because they wouldn't clock out because they're  
6    working through their lunch but -- and not taking a  
7    lunch hour I should say -- but if they're taking a  
8    lunch, they should clock out for it.

9           And we're encouraging people to take an  
10   hour because that's the County's policy and, at a  
11   very minimum, at least a half-hour because, again, we  
12   want folks to get away from their desk for a bit and  
13   get away from their work for a little bit for their  
14   own mental wellbeing.

15           MEMBER SINNOTT:  Tim, do you see a  
16   problem with this as written?

17           MR. LECKLIDER:  No.

18           DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE:  We'd be looking  
19   for a motion to approve this.

20           MEMBER SEXTON:  I move that the Board  
21   approve the employee time accounting procedure  
22   governing full-time and seasonal employees of the  
23   Franklin County Board of Elections as outlined on  
24   Exhibit C.

25           MEMBER SINNOTT:  Second.

1           DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All those in  
2 favor, signify by saying aye.

3           (Thereupon, all members voted  
4 affirmatively.)

5           DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All opposed, same  
6 sign.

7           (No response.)

8           DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Motion carries.

9           Typically in General Elections, when we  
10 expect a significant voter turnout, we have voting --  
11 Early Vote Managers; one Republican and one Democrat.

12           And, Zach, do you want -- you're the  
13 Manager of that department, do you want to explain --

14           MR. MANIFOLD: The contracts in front of  
15 you for Vote Center Managers are the same, it's the  
16 same contract we've had the last couple of years.  
17 Same price -- or same contract amount and everything.  
18 It goes from up to \$10,000 for the payout for six  
19 weeks and there is an additional \$500 that's budgeted  
20 in if, for some reason, there is extended hours from  
21 legal action.

22           That kind of hangs over from years ago.  
23 We used to have -- and we still list it on the hours,  
24 subject to change. You never know when something  
25 will pop up. So we still have that extra \$500 in

1 there if something were to happen. But it's the same  
 2 contract we had for the last couple years for one  
 3 Democrat and one Republican.

4 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: What's the  
 5 commencement date?

6 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Today.

7 MR. MANIFOLD: Today. They're actually  
 8 here setting up today.

9 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Oh, I see, right at  
 10 the top, October 2.

11 MEMBER MARINELLO: They did that for  
 12 free.

13 (Laughter all around.)

14 MR. MANIFOLD: They did. I worked them a  
 15 lot today.

16 MEMBER MARINELLO: I move that the Board  
 17 authorize the Director and Deputy Director to execute  
 18 personal service contracts not to exceed \$10,500 for  
 19 Brandi Wielgopolski and Brian McCann to manage the  
 20 Early Vote Center located at 1700 Morse Road  
 21 Columbus, Ohio.

22 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Is there a  
 23 second?

24 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: I will second it with  
 25 the observation we've made before that we like

1 Brandi, and Brian, we know Brian, but we particularly  
 2 like Brandi because of her last name W-i-e-l- "g-o-p"  
 3 -o-l-s-k-i.

4 (Laughter all around.)

5 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Second.

6 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All in favor,  
 7 signify by saying aye.

8 (Thereupon, all members voted  
 9 affirmatively.)

10 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All opposed, same  
 11 sign.

12 (No response.)

13 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Motion carries.

14 This is the third year we'd like to have  
 15 the Legacy of Trainers Banquet. I think at least I  
 16 know that Board Member Marinello has been to one,  
 17 maybe two of those events.

18 MEMBER MARINELLO: Both.

19 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Both of them, all  
 20 right. I've been very impressed with those, and I  
 21 think anybody that's attended those would say they're  
 22 well done and well-deserved recognition for our  
 23 trainers.

24 Do you want to explain a little bit about  
 25 the --

1 MR. BULEN: Yes, sir. Thank you, Deputy  
2 Director Payne.

3 Mr. Chairman, members of the Board, as  
4 the Deputy Director said, this would be our third  
5 Legacy of Trainers event, and it's a great  
6 opportunity to not only honor the hardworking  
7 trainers, but also we've expanded it to include some  
8 other folks such as longstanding Board of Elections  
9 employees; we recognized a couple of them last  
10 dinner.

11 We also recognize the partnership with a  
12 church that we work with that has been a  
13 long-standing training site, off-site here, and so we  
14 honored them for their partnership.

15 And we're talking this time around to  
16 expand and recognize our partnership with the Dublin  
17 City Schools and the PREP Program where they provide  
18 disabled adults to serve as precinct election  
19 officials on Election Day.

20 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Now, who was invited  
21 to the last two?

22 MR. BULEN: Who has been invited?

23 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: To the last -- to the  
24 first two.

25 MR. BULEN: Board members, Director,

1 Deputy Director, staff --

2 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: The trainers?

3 MR. BULEN: Yes, the trainers. Board of  
4 Election staff. So we've expanded it, and Robin Link  
5 and Dan Steward have worked real hard on --

6 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: How many trainers  
7 would be invited this time?

8 MR. BULEN: We have, I think,  
9 Mr. Chairman, 38 trainers, 36, 40, somewhere in  
10 there.

11 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Was it done here?

12 MR. BULEN: It was done here both times.

13 MEMBER SINNOTT: How many attended last  
14 year?

15 MR. BULEN: 60, I would think. 60  
16 people.

17 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: They're  
18 encouraged to bring their spouse, correct?

19 MR. BULEN: Special guests are encouraged  
20 to bring their spouses; trainers we might be  
21 honoring. We have an ongoing award for length of  
22 service. So there's a couple trainers that will  
23 receive special awards this time around.

24 DIRECTOR LEONARD: Some of the award  
25 recipients included precinct officials -- precinct

1 election officials, so they were there along with  
2 some family members. We recognized Dr. Glyde Marsh  
3 last year and Ms. Beverly --

4 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Bev Truax.

5 DIRECTOR LEONARD: -- Truax, who is the  
6 one who served as a poll worker the day after her  
7 husband passed.

8 So again, it's -- and again, the fact  
9 that our trainers are the ones who train the poll  
10 workers, folks -- the general public doesn't get an  
11 opportunity to interact with the Board on a regular  
12 basis and most times that they do it's through the  
13 precinct election officials, the poll workers.

14 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: A lot of the trainers  
15 are workers themselves, poll workers?

16 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: I'd say on some  
17 special elections they do. But they're the ones who  
18 train those poll workers and that's the importance of  
19 them training those poll workers because those poll  
20 workers are the face of the Board of Elections to the  
21 vast majority of the public, so recognizing their  
22 work is very worthwhile for the Board to do.

23 MEMBER SINNOTT: Well, it sounds like you  
24 might have more than 60 this year if we're expanding  
25 the invitees.

1           DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE:  It's -- it's just  
2 -- but it's -- it's similar to the Beverly Truax and  
3 the Glyde Marsh in that if we find exemplary folks  
4 that work with election day officials like the PREP  
5 Dublin, we'll add them this year and give them a  
6 special award.  So they won't be on it necessarily  
7 next year, but they are this year.  So we're giving  
8 them a special award for their partnership with the  
9 Board of Elections.

10           MR. BULEN:  Integrated in is kind of this  
11 ability --

12           DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE:  But you're right,  
13 there might be more people.

14           MR. BULEN:  -- to recognize special  
15 people or special organizations each dinner, so.

16           CHAIRMAN PREISSE:  Thank you.

17           MEMBER SINNOTT:  As a practical matter,  
18 do we cater the dinner in?  How is the food?

19           MEMBER MARINELLO:  Who did it last year?

20           DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE:  It's catered and  
21 we will ask for three, not necessarily bids, but --

22           DIRECTOR LEONARD:  Quotes.

23           DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE:  -- quotes to make  
24 sure that we get the lowest quote.

25           MEMBER SINNOTT:  All right.  I move that

1 the Board accept a resolution authorizing the staff  
2 to hold a Legacy of Trainer Awards Dinner to be held  
3 on Tuesday, November 28th, 2017, at the Franklin  
4 County Board of Elections, and that the Board also  
5 authorize that the cost of the Legacy of Trainers  
6 Dinner be not more than \$2,500.

7 MEMBER MARINELLO: Second.

8 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All those in  
9 favor, signify by saying aye.

10 (Thereupon, all members voted  
11 affirmatively.)

12 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All opposed, same  
13 sign.

14 (No response.)

15 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Motion carries.

16 The final item on the agenda deals with  
17 holiday hours. As you know, Early Vote starts  
18 October 11th. Columbus Day, which is a federal and  
19 state and county holiday, falls on October 9th. So  
20 our office will not be open to the public, but  
21 obviously the Board of Elections will have work that  
22 needs to be completed, so all the Board of Elections  
23 staff will come in on October 9th.

24 And then, in lieu of that, we would like  
25 to have Friday, November 24th, which would be the day

1 after Thanksgiving. So we'd swap Columbus Day with  
2 the day after Thanksgiving if the Board sees fit.

3 MEMBER SEXTON: Okay. I move that the  
4 Board offices will remain open for staff only, not to  
5 the general public, on Columbus Day, Monday, October  
6 9th, and will be tentatively closed on Friday,  
7 November 24th.

8 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Second.

9 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All those in  
10 favor, signify by saying aye.

11 (Thereupon, all members voted  
12 affirmatively.)

13 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All opposed, same  
14 sign.

15 (No response.)

16 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Motion carries.

17 And unless there's any new business to  
18 come before the Board, I think we're in the mood for  
19 adjournment.

20 MEMBER SINNOTT: I move we adjourn.

21 MEMBER MARINELLO: Second.

22 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All those opposed  
23 -- or, all in favor, signify by saying aye.

24 (Thereupon, all members voted  
25 affirmatively.)

**SOS Directive 2015-15. II(A)** Boards of elections using direct recording electronic (DRE) voting machines as their primary voting system on Election Day should deploy at least one DRE voting machine for every 175 registered voters in a precinct or voting location at which the DREs are programmed to allow any voter in the location to vote on any machine in the location. In determining the number of registered voters, a board does not have to count electors who have failed to respond within 30 days to any confirmation notice. It may also exclude from the count any registered voter who has requested an absent voter ballot (by mail or in person) for the Election as of the date the allocation decision is made by the board. There must never be fewer than two (2) DRE voting machines in any precinct or voting location.

### **EMPLOYEE TIME ACCOUNTING PROCEDURE**

All Board of Elections employees must use the time accounting system.

Employees will use their county-issued employee identification card to activate the system each day the employee works on site. Once in the system, the employee needs to click on the "in" button when coming into the office or one of the "out" options when leaving the office. It is the employee's responsibility to ensure the camera captures their face when checking in or out. Employee may adjust the angle of camera to suit their needs, but in no way are employees permitted to purposefully move the camera so a picture cannot be taken.

New employees will be provided with an alternative identification number to use until their county-issued identification card is provided to them.

Employees are prohibited from having someone else check them in or out. Employees who are found to be in violation of this are subject to discipline.

Employees must check-out for lunch and are encouraged to take a one-hour lunch break. Whether or not an employee leaves the building, employees are encouraged to take a minimum of one-half hour (30 minute) lunch break.

Managers and D/DD are to inspect the bi-weekly time sheets against the time accounting system. If a discrepancy exists showing less time worked than claimed, the employee will be required to submit a written explanation for any shortage of time claimed. The manager or D/DD may require the employee to amend their bi-weekly time sheet.

Employees leaving the office for a work-related purpose should use the "Out-On Clock" option and provide an explanation of the task they are completing. Simply putting a response such as "PO" or "Picking up mail" are not sufficient. Alternatively, a more acceptable description would be "Post office to drop off absentee ballots."

Failure to comply with time accounting procedures may result in disciplinary action.
