21	2025, and March 3rd, 2025, meetings of the Franklin
22	County Board of Elections as submitted.
23	ACTING CHAIRMAN FREEDHOFF: Second.
24	DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: It's been

1 properly moved and seconded. 2 All those in favor of the motion, signify by saying "aye." 3 4 (Vote taken.) 5 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All opposed, 6 same sign. 7 (No response.) 8 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Motion 9 carries. 10 The next item on the agenda is the 11 ballot allocation for the May 6 Primary Election. 12 We were required by the Secretary of State to do 13 allocation formulas for both paper ballots and 14 voting machines and electronic poll books. And 15 I'll turn that over to Carla Patton to discuss the 16 ballot allocation. 17 MS. PATTON: Good afternoon. 18 Before you, you have Exhibit A, 19 which is the 2025 Primary Special Election initial 20 paper ballot allocation, ah, requests that we have 21 put together for paper ballots this election. 22 The Election Official Manual, 23 Chapter 5, Section 5.07, Ballot Quantities requires 24 that we look at a previous like election and

allocate that number of provisional ballots that was cast in the previous like election, plus an additional five percent.

For this -- for this election, I went back to 2017, as that was the last time that the City of Columbus and the Columbus City School Board held Primary Elections, so that was the most similar like election that I could go to for numbers.

The number of provisional ballots cast in any one location was under ten. ensure that we got that, that was equivalent to less than one percent of the registered voters. So I lumped in the provisional ballots along with the elections day paper ballot since we are -- for the most part voters use the ballot-marking device; not many request paper ballots. So to encompass all the requirements for the provisionals, as well as at the Board -- at our discretion, the -- the recommended allocation of Election Day paper ballots for regular voters, I took five percent of the registered voters in each precinct and then took that number and rounded it up to the next increment of 25. So if five percent equaled 51

1 voters, then they are getting a pad -- they're getting three pads of 25 for 75 ballots within --2 for that precinct. So that is the formula that --3 The results -- the results in front 4 5 of you on Exhibit A are the results of that 6 formula, and this is what we would recommend for 7 the allocation for this election. 8 DIRECTOR WHITE: If the need arises 9 on Election Day for additional ballots? 10 MS. PATTON: Yeah. So in the event 11 that a precinct is beginning to run low on paper 12 ballots on Election Day or if we see that we're 13 having an issue with the machines, we do have our 14 print shop that will print those ballots on demand 15 as quickly as we need them, and we can get -- turn 16 those ballots out within a -- turn them around to 17 the locations within an hour of their request at 18 the maximum amount of time. 19 DIRECTOR WHITE: Thank you. 20 MEMBER MARINELLO: Has that ever 21 happened? Have you run out? 22 MS. PATTON: We have -- In very few 23 instances have we ran out, but that's because

there's been some kind of issue going on at the

location with some of the ballot markers. But usually in an election like this, I can't recall ever really having to produce additional ballots.

In November, I think that there were a few locations that we did produce additional paper ballots and sent out on Election Day, but that was well later into the afternoon, and it was just due to one of those being Ohio Union where we serve a lot of campus voters and a high number of provisionals do occur. So I think that was the one location, as well as potentially I believe it was a couple Hilliard locations because they had something on their ballot that was also driving turnout.

MEMBER MARINELLO: Thank you.

ACTING CHAIRMAN FREEDHOFF: Thank
you, Carla. Did you also say you round up by 25?

MS. PATTON: Yeah. So our pads run
with no -- with pads -- are pads of 25 ballots. So
rather than rounding down, everything was rounded
up to 25.

ACTING CHAIRMAN FREEDHOFF: Okay.

23 Anybody else have any more questions?

18	with the ballot or with the allocation for
19	voting machines and electronic poll books.
20	MS. PATTON: So Exhibit B should be
21	in your files there, which is the initial voting
22	equipment allocation for the 2025 Primary Special
23	Election. These numbers are ran by location
24	versus instead of precinct as is in the paper

ballots.

So you have the Express Vote tabletops. Those are being allocated at one for every 340 voters for this election. And the kiosk, which is -- kiosks, which are the same thing as the tabletops and then a kiosk form to handle more the ADA voters, those are allocated at one per 4,100 voters, with no location getting less than two tabletops and one kiosk.

So you will see that there is a total, then, number of Express Votes, which combines those; and the total number of ballot marking devices between the tabletops and the kiosks are 3,173 that's being allocated for this election.

The DS200s are being allocated at one per 2,520 voters, with no less than one at any given location.

And then also you have the touchpads, which are electronic poll books; and those are being allocated at one per 900 voters.

So there are a total of 501 DS200s going out and a total of 1,245 of the touchpads allocated to go out.

1	We did run these numbers with a
2	little lesser ratio than what was ran in the
3	general based on predicted turnout. And we do have
4	available units to go out at a moment's notice in
5	the event that we find a location is is backing
6	up or needs more equipment. So we do have the
7	ability to pull any additional units as needed on
8	Election Day, again, within a short turnaround
9	time.
10	So we would ask that you approve the
11	Exhibit B, Allocation Equipment for the 2025
12	Primary Special as it's presented to you.
13	MEMBER MARINELLO: Any questions
14	anyone?
15	(No response.)
16	MEMBER MARINELLO: Madam Chairman,
17	Kim Marinello.
18	I move that Board adopt the voting
19	machine allocation formula in Exhibit B compiled by
20	the Board staff for the May 6, 2025, Primary

19	I'd like to request the purchase
20	of the Cradlepoint security software. It's the
21	intrusion prevention software that the Secretary of
22	State requires that all wireless networks have.
23	We use our wireless networks at our
24	polling locations during the during Election Day

1	and the night before to help make sure that our
2	electronic poll books are up to date.
3	MEMBER SEXTON: Is this is
4	this How often do we do this?
5	MR. JEFF GATWOOD: It's a yearly
6	license.
7	MEMBER SEXTON: Yearly license? So
8	this will be good for the
9	MR. JEFF GATWOOD: For the main one,
10	yeah.
11	MEMBER SEXTON: The primary and
12	general?
13	MR. JEFF GATWOOD: Yes, correct.
14	MEMBER SEXTON: Madam Chair, I move
15	that the Board purchase Cradlepoint software from
16	the Source, Inc., in the amount of \$48,081.
17	ACTING CHAIRMAN FREEDHOFF: I
18	second.
19	DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: It's been
20	properly moved and seconded.
21	All those in favor of the motion,
22	significant by saying "aye."
23	(Vote taken.)
21	DEDITTY DIDECTOR DAYNE: All opposed

1 same sign. 2 (No response.) 3 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: The motion 4 carries. Thank you, Jeff. 5 6 MR. JEFF GATWOOD: Thank you. 7 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: The next 8 item on the agenda is the purchase of Ballot Remake 9 Stations, and I'll turn that over to Adam Slane, 10 who is a member of our Absentee Ballot Department. 11 MR. ADAM SLANE: Good afternoon, 12 Chairman Freedhoff and members of the Board. 13 I'm Adam Slane. I'm a clerk in the 14 Absentee Division. I'm here to ask for your 15 approval of a purchase order so that we can 16 purchase three enhanced remake stations. 17 Currently, just so -- for -- so you 18 know how we currently handle remakes, we do that by 19 hand. So they're printed on demand as we need 20 them, and two Board staff sit down and call back and forth what's on the original voter's ballot and 21 22 mark it on the new one. That takes about ten 23 minutes start to finish per ballot. And last year

in the Presidential General Election, we had just

shy of about 3,000 remakes total.

That includes all the UOCAVA ballots that are sent out to voters electronically that must return a hard copy. But since they received it electronically, they don't naturally have it on real ballot stock. It also includes any ballot that just will not scan on the scanners, as well as ballots from polling locations, mostly the provisionals that are marked in a way that doesn't allow them also to be scanned.

Rounding up to 3,000 total ballots, that is about 30,000 minutes, 500 hours or 20 days' worth of time to execute getting all of the ballots that needed remade in last year's Presidential General Election.

The equipment on the purchase order that we're seeking to buy, it's three stations.

One will be for the -- in the Early Vote Center, and one -- two would be back in the absentee vault.

They serve more than just the ability to help with remakes. They also will serve as on-demand ballot printers so that we can fulfill any needs that people have by paper by choice in the vote center, as well as any of our on-demand

ballot needs we need in the vault, such as the nursing home ballots that are printed in case the Relia-Vote equipment happens to mangle a ballot, it can't be stuffed, and any other sort of on-demand needs that we have.

We anticipate this cutting in half the time it takes to do remakes. So had we had this last year in the Presidential General Election, it would have only taken about ten days' worth of time to achieve all of the remakes instead of the 20 days' worth of time that it took to achieve all of the remakes.

Naturally, I don't do that all by myself with just my partner. I would have spent the entire month of October doing it.

So we enlisted all of our seasonal staff to help, the absentee full-time staff. I'd even have the director and deputy come in and help when we are really in the weeds with achieving that.

So that's just time. It's not what two people do, but 20 days' worth of time is what it took to achieve it last year.

This will greatly help modernize our

1	process and speed up our process, and I also
2	believe it will ensure a lot more accuracy in our
3	process, as well.
4	DIRECTOR WHITE: And just for
5	reference, we looked at this software last year,
6	and we we had a demo. We spoke with the
7	company. We were we were convinced this would
8	be a benefit to us.
9	But we decided not to move forward
10	last year, the presidential year. We didn't think
11	that was prudent, the Deputy Director and I, so
12	that's why we waited until this year where we could
13	purchase the software and use it in a smaller
14	election. But we think it will really greatly
15	enhance our our process here.
16	ACTING CHAIRMAN FREEDHOFF: Thank
17	you, Adam.
18	When will this be up and running?
19	MR. ADAM SLANE: They come tomorrow
20	to install as long as you approve it. So we should
21	be good to go and start using it immediately.
22	DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Assuming we
23	approve it.
24	MR. ADAM SLANE: Assuming the Board

1 approves it. 2 ACTING CHAIRMAN FREEDHOFF: So for 3 this election will be the first time you use it? 4 MR. ADAM SLANE: Yes, and -- and 5 practice. 6 ACTING CHAIRMAN FREEDHOFF: 7 MR. ADAM SLANE: As the Director 8 said, they've come and demonstrated the equipment 9 twice to us, the -- the team that needs to know. 10 I discovered them at an Election 11 Official Conference a couple years ago and had a 12 demonstration, and I -- I do think it will be very 13 helpful equipment for the absentee team to achieve 14 some of the things that we do. 15 Like I said, it -- the -- the 16 equipment serves not only as an ability to help us 17 remake ballots, but it also serves as an on-demand 18 printer. Currently that is another point where we 19 could be more efficient. 20

The print settings to ensure the ballots are printed so none of the ink or anything fades away and chips away, thereby causing another remake, only my laptop could be plugged into the printer.

1 So if the nursing home team needed 2 ballots, I had to be available to print them. Ιf 3 Seth and Brady, our -- our reliable team who do the 4 outbound ballots, if one of -- if their machine needed a ballot, I had to print it for them. 5 If --6 When we needed the hospital ballots, I had to print 7 them because if you plugged in a new laptop, it 8 would wipe the heat settings on the printer. 9 This equipment will allow any of the 10 full-time staff to print ballots as they need on 11 demand in a bipartisan fashion, just saving further 12 time. 13 If Seth and Brady need a ballot and 14 I'm not available, they can print one together and 15 keep doing their job and not have to wait for me to 16 get in there to print a ballot, delaying getting 17 the outbound ballots that day. 18 If Chris Cooper, our nursing home 19 team guy needs ballots, he'll take care of it. 20 So it will serve multiple purposes 21 and hopefully speed up to make things more 22 efficient for us in absentee. 23 ACTING CHAIRMAN FREEDHOFF: Sounds

like a good find.
