In- Person Absentee Voting Expands

(Columbus) In-person absentee voting expands starting today to begin the final two weeks of early voting for the general election.

Franklin County's early voting center at 1700 Morse Road, Columbus will be open at the following dates and times:

- **Weekdays through Thursday, Nov. 1- 8:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.**
- **Friday, Nov. 2- 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.**
- **Saturday, Nov. 3- 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.**
- **Sunday, Nov. 4- 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.**
- **Monday, Nov. 5 – 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.**

Totals as of this morning show more than 182,000 Franklin County voters have requested absentee ballots in person and by mail since early voting began Oct. 2 compared to approximately 193,000 at this point of early voting in 2008.
