Absentee Voting Begins Next Tuesday for Primary Election

(Columbus) Absentee voting, both in-person and by mail, begins next week for the May 5, 2015 primary/special election.

In-person early voting will run from Tuesday, April 7 through Monday, May 4 and take place in Franklin County at the board of elections, located at 1700 Morse Road, Columbus at the following times:

- **Weekdays, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. except for Monday, May 4 when in-person voting will run from 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.**
- **Saturday, May 2 from 8:00 am. to noon**
- **Sunday, May 3 from 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.**

There are no countywide issues on this year's primary ballot. Columbus, Gahanna and Reynoldsburg will hold primaries for city offices including mayor and council. Candidates for Columbus Board of Education will appear on ballots throughout the school district. Tax levies will appear in the Villages of Minerva Park and Valley View and in Hamilton, Madison, Perry and Plain Townships.

Voters planning to cast a ballot by mail must request one by May 4 at noon. Applications are available online at <http://vote.franklincountyohio.gov>, at public libraries or by calling the board of elections at (614) 525-3100.

Voters must be registered by Monday, April 6, the day before the primary, to be eligible for this election.
