Accessible Sample Ballots for Visually Impaired Voters Available Online

(Columbus) Absentee voting for the primary begins in less than two weeks, but Franklin County's registered voters can already see what their ballot will look like when they vote early or on Election Day. Registered Franklin County voters can visit <https://vote.franklincountyohio.gov/search/> to pull up their sample ballot.

This primary marks the second consecutive election that accessible sample ballots have been available for residents with visual impairments. These sample ballots are formatted to be screen reader friendly. Election Day and absentee formatted ballots can be viewed or printed from the link just below the accessible sample ballot.

Franklin County will have 956 different ballot styles this primary election in its 369 voting locations countywide.

Voters must request and submit an application for an absentee ballot in order to vote absentee in the May 2, 2017 primary election. Applications are available online at our website or by calling the board of elections at (614) 525-3470.
