National Voter Registration Day 2017

(Columbus) In recognition of National Voter Registration Day, the Franklin County Board of Elections wants to remind voters that only two weeks remain in Franklin County and Ohio to register to vote in the November 7, 2017 general election. Voter registrations must be received by Tuesday, October 10, 2017. The Franklin County Board of Elections will be open until 9:00 p.m. October 10 to accept registrations.

Registration forms are available at <http://vote.franklincountyohio.gov> and at the following locations where they can also be submitted:

- *Ohio Secretary of State, 180 E. Broad Street, Columbus
- *Any public high school, vocational school, college, public library or BMV.
- *Agencies providing public assistance and disability programs.
- *Franklin County Treasurer, 373 S. High Street, Columbus.

Registered voters who have changed their name and/or address need to update their registration by October 10 to vote a regular ballot in the general election. New registrations and/or changes can be made by mail as well as in person at 1700 Morse Road or online through the secretary of state's website <http://MyOhioVote.com>.

Registration is open to U.S. citizens living in Franklin County at least thirty days prior to the election and who will be at least 18 years old by Election Day. The latest totals show there are more than 851,000 registered voters in Franklin County.
