Registration Deadline for May 7th Primary Election is Monday, April 8th

(Columbus) The Franklin County Board of Elections reminds voters the deadline to register to vote or change one's address or name for the May 7th Primary Election is Monday, April 8th.

The Board of Elections, located at 1700 Morse Road, will remain open Monday until 9:00 p.m. for voters to register or deliver their completed forms to our office. Voters may also go online at <http://myohiovote.com> to register to vote with a valid Ohio driver's license or update an existing registration.

Registrations by mail are acceptable if they are postmarked by April 8, 2019. Registration forms are available at our office and on the Web at <http://vote.franklincountyohio.gov>. Forms may also be found at many government offices throughout the county. To be eligible to vote, one must be a U.S. citizen, a resident of Ohio for at least 30 days before the election, registered to vote at least 30 days before the election, and at least 18 years old on or before May 7th.

When voting remember these three steps to a counted ballot:

Mark, Verify, Vote!
