In-Person Absentee Voting Begins Tomorrow

(Columbus) Absentee voting, both in-person and by mail, begins tomorrow Tuesday, October 8th for the November 5th General Election. To date over 4,600 absentee ballot applications have been returned to the Franklin County Board of Elections. Those ballots will hit the mail tomorrow coinciding with the first day of in-person early voting. In-person early voting will run from Tuesday, October 8th, 2019 through Monday, November 4th, 2019 and take place at the Board of Elections located at 1700 Morse Road, Columbus at the following times:

- Tuesday, October 8th to Friday, October 25th (Weekdays) - 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.
- Monday, October 28th to Friday, November 1st (Weekdays) - 8:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m.
- Saturday, November 2nd - 8:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m.
- Sunday, November 3rd - 1:00 p.m. – 5:00 p.m.
- Monday, November 4th - 8:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m.

The deadline to register to vote or update your registration for the November 5th General Election is today Monday, October 7th at 9:00 p.m.
