### **Voter Registration Deadline for March 17<sup>th</sup> Primary is Tomorrow**

**(Columbus)** Franklin County residents that are not registered have until 9:00 p.m. tomorrow Tuesday, February 18<sup>th</sup> to register to be eligible to vote in the March 17<sup>th</sup> Primary Election. Below are the requirements one must meet to be a qualified voter:

- Must be a U.S. citizen
- A resident of Ohio for at least 30 days before the election
- Registered to vote at least 30 days before the election
- At least 18 years old on or before November 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2020

To register or update registration online please visit, <http://voteohio.gov> you will need to provide the following:

- Ohio driver's license or Ohio identification card number
- Name
- Date of Birth
- Address
- Last four digits of your Social Security number

The Board of Elections, located at 1700 Morse Road, will remain open Tuesday, February 18<sup>th</sup> until 9:00 p.m. for voters to register or deliver their completed forms to our office.

Registrations by mail are acceptable if they are postmarked by February 18<sup>th</sup>, 2020. Registration forms are available at our office and on the Web at <http://vote.franklincountyohio.gov>. Forms may also be found at many government offices throughout the county.
