**(Columbus)** Absentee voting, both in-person and by mail, begins February 19<sup>th</sup> for the March 17<sup>th</sup>, 2020 Primary Election. As of yesterday over 6,100 absentee ballots have been requested in Franklin County. Those will begin hitting the mail tomorrow to coincide with the first day of early voting. **Saturday, March 14<sup>th</sup> from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.**

**Sunday, March 15<sup>th</sup> from 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.**

**Monday, March 16<sup>th</sup> from 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.**
