Primary Election Update

(Columbus) The Franklin County Board of Elections is accepting absentee ballot applications and preparing to mail ballots. Any registered voter that has not already cast a ballot in the Primary Election can request an absentee application by calling 614-525-3470 or downloading the form on our website, <http://vote.franklincountyohio.gov>. Completed absentee ballot requests must be mailed to us at 1700 Morse Road, Columbus, Ohio 43229.

The Board will be thoroughly reviewing today's legislation regarding an all-mail ballot to conclude the postponed March 17th election. Today's legislation sets Tuesday, April 28th, 2020 as the date ballots must be returned. Today's bill awaits the signature of the Governor to become law.

Further information will be forthcoming as we work with the Secretary of State on implementation.
