## **National Voter Registration Day 2021**

(**Columbus**) In recognition of NVR Day the Franklin County Board of Elections wants to remind voters that less than one week remains to register to vote in the November 2, 2021 General Election. Voter registrations must be received by Monday, October 4, 2021. The Franklin County Board of Elections will be open until 9:00 p.m. October 4<sup>th</sup> to accept registrations.

Registration forms are available at <a href="http://vote.franklincountyohio.gov">http://vote.franklincountyohio.gov</a> and at the following locations where they can also be submitted:

- Ohio Secretary of State, 180 E. Broad Street, Columbus
- Any public high school, vocational school, college, public library or BMV
- Agencies providing public assistance and disability programs
- Franklin County Treasurer, 373 S. High Street, Columbus

Registered voters who have changed their name and/or address need to update their registration by October 4<sup>th</sup> to vote a regular ballot in the General Election. New registrations and/or changes may be sent by mail and postmarked no later than October 4<sup>th</sup>; filed online through the Secretary of State's website, <a href="http://ohiosos.gov">http://ohiosos.gov</a>: or delivered to the Board of Elections, located at 1700 Morse Road by 9:00 p.m. on October 4<sup>th</sup>.

Registration is open to U.S. citizens living in Franklin County at least thirty days prior to the election and who will be at least 18 years old by Election Day. The latest totals show there are more than 865,000 registered voters in Franklin County.
