## May 2, 2023 Primary/Special Election is Tomorrow

(**Columbus**) Election Day is tomorrow for roughly four percent of registered voters across the county. In total eighteen voting locations will be open to handle certified races and issues. Eligible voters (see below) can cast a ballot in person tomorrow from 6:30 a.m. thru 7:30 p.m.

The <u>City of Gahanna</u> will have candidates on the ballot to vote on for the May 2 Primary/Special Election. Voters in Madison Plains School District have a bond issue to decide.
