Voter Registration Deadline for August 8 Special Election is Today

(**Columbus**) Franklin County residents that are not registered to vote or need to update their voter registration have until 9:00 p.m. today to be eligible to vote in the August 8 Special Election. Voters will decide a statewide amendment that would require any future constitutional amendments to be approved by at least 60% of the voters. That is the only item that voters will see on the ballot.

Below are the requirements one must meet to be a qualified voter:

- Must be a U.S. citizen
- A resident of Ohio for at least 30 days before the election
- Registered to vote at least 30 days before the election

To register or update your registration online please visit, http://voteohio.gov. Registrants will need to provide the following:

- Name
- Date of Birth
- Address
- Applicants need to provide only one of these items: Ohio driver's license number, Ohio identification card number, or last four digits of Social Security number

The Franklin County Board of Elections, located at 1700 Morse Road, will remain open today until 9:00 p.m. for voters to register or deliver their completed forms to our office. Registrations by mail are acceptable if they are postmarked today, Monday, July 10, 2023.
