## Temporary Voting Location Change Notifications Mailed for August 8, 2023 Special Election

(**Columbus**) Voting location change notifications were mailed today informing 66,320 Franklin County registered voters that their voting location will temporarily change for the August 8, 2023, Special Election. 282 voting locations will be available for the upcoming Primary Election.

"Due to the timing of this special election, many of our standard voting locations were unavailable because of pre-planned events and other activities," said Board of Elections Director Antone White. "In addition to the mailed notices, voters are encouraged to verify their voting location by visiting our website or by calling our office to ensure a smooth voting experience."

Franklin County voters can verify their August 8<sup>th</sup> voting location by searching their voter record using the *My Registration* feature on our website at <u>vote.franklincountyohio.gov</u>, or by contacting our office at 614-525-3100. The Board of Elections will also place signage at all past voting locations not in use for August 8<sup>th</sup> informing voters of their temporary voting location (name & address).

## **Early Vote Options**

As a reminder, Franklin County voters can still cast an early in-person ballot at the Board of Elections, located at 1700 Morse Road, now through August 6<sup>th</sup> at 5:00 pm. <u>Vote-by-Mail ballots can be requested now through August 1<sup>st</sup> at 8:30 pm</u>. Early vote hours and absentee ballot requests can be found on the Board of Elations website.

Election Day is Tuesday, August 8th polls open at 6:30 a.m. and close at 7:30 p.m.
