Franklin County Board of Elections Celebrates National Poll Worker Recruitment Day

(**Columbus**) National Poll Worker Recruitment Day is a day established by the U.S. Election Assistance Commission to encourage people to serve as poll workers. Its creation aims to address the critical shortage of poll workers, strengthen our democracy, inspire greater civic engagement and volunteerism, and help ensure free and fair elections in November and beyond.

"Bi-partisan poll workers serve as the backbone to our main function of administering fair, impartial, and accurate elections here in the largest county in Ohio, said Franklin County Board of Elections Director Antone White."

Earlier this summer members of the Franklin County Board of Elections voted unanimously for a well-deserved pay increase for Franklin County poll workers. The permanent pay increase is vital in continuing to recruit and retain a large and talented pool of Poll Workers in a competitive marketplace.

A full countywide election requires upwards of 5,000 Poll Workers on Election Day. Registered voters in Franklin County over the age of 17 who have not been convicted of a felony are eligible to become poll workers.
