Absentee In-Person Voting Concludes Sunday

(Columbus) Three days remain to vote absentee in-person at the Franklin County Board of Elections. Below are the days and hours left to vote at our office, including this weekend. To date 29,798 registered voters, have either voted in-person or requested a ballot be mailed to them.

Absentee In-Person Hours

Friday, March 15th - 7:30 a.m. – 7:30 p.m.

Saturday, March 16th - 8:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.

Sunday, March 17th - 1:00 p.m. – 5:00 p.m. **(FINAL DAY TO VOTE EARLY IN-PERSON)**

Absentee ballots returned by mail must be postmarked no later than Monday, March 18th and received by Saturday, March 23rd to be included in the official certified results. Voters who want to return their voted absentee mail-in ballot can deliver them to the board, 1700 Morse Road, Columbus to its secure 24/7 drop box. Absentee ballots being delivered to our office must be received no later than 7:30 p.m. on Tuesday, March 19th.

Franklin County will have 304 voting locations open on Election Day, Tuesday, March 19th. Voters must go to their assigned voting location on Election Day to cast a ballot. Polls open at 6:30 a.m. and close at 7:30 p.m.
