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Deadline to Submit Absentee Mail Application is October 29

(Columbus) The deadline to submit a valid application for an absentee ballot by mail for the November 5 General Election is <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>October 29</u>, <u>2024</u> at 8:30 p.m. This deadline is part of legislation passed in House Bill 458 that went into effect back in 2023. After this date, registered voters who want to vote will have to vote at the Franklin County Board of Elections early in-person vote center located at 1700 Morse Road, or their assigned Election Day voting location.
