### **Voting Location Change Notifications Mailed for May 6, 2025 Primary/Special Election**

**(Columbus)** Voting location change notifications are being mailed tomorrow informing 44,205 Franklin County registered voters that their voting location will change for the May 6, 2025, Primary/Special Election.

298 voting locations will be available for the upcoming Primary/Special Election. Franklin County voters can verify their May 6<sup>th</sup> voting location by searching their voter record using the **My Registration** feature on our website at <http://vote.franklincountyohio.gov>, or by contacting our office at 614-525-3100. The Board of Elections will also place signage at all voting locations not in use for May 6<sup>th</sup> informing voters of their voting location (name & address).

### **Early Vote Options**

As a reminder, Franklin County voters can still cast an early in-person ballot at the Board of Elections, located at 1700 Morse Road, now through May 4<sup>th</sup>. Vote-by-Mail ballots can be requested now through April 29<sup>th</sup> at 8:30 p.m. Early vote hours and absentee ballot request applications can be found on the Board of Elections website.

**Election Day is Tuesday, May 6, 2025 polls open at 6:30 a.m. and close at 7:30 p.m.**
