Early Vote In-Person Hours Expand Next Week

(**Columbus**) Beginning next week, the Franklin County Board of Elections will ramp up expanded early in-person voting hours in accordance with Ohio Revised Code. Below are the in-person voting hours that Franklin County registered voters can vote at 1700 Morse Road, Columbus:

- Monday, April 28 from 7:30 a.m. to 7:30 p.m.
- Tuesday, April 29 from 7:30 a.m. to 8:30 p.m. *Last Day to Request Absentee Ballots
- Wednesday, April 30 through Friday, May 2 from 7:30 a.m. to 7:30 p.m.
- Saturday, May 3 from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
- Sunday, May 4 from 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Voters have until Tuesday, April 29 at 8:30 p.m. to submit an absentee ballot by mail application. Applications can be found on our website by visiting https://vote.franklincountyohio.gov/ or by calling our office at 614-525-3470.

Voters who want to hand deliver their voted absentee ballot can return it to the board's secured ballot drop box located at 1700 Morse Road. If you are assisting another voter with the return of a ballot, you must see a board of elections official who can provide you with the necessary attestation form.

Ballots mailed back must be postmarked no later than May 5th or can be dropped off to our office by 7:30 p.m. on Election Day. More election information can be found including a voter's sample ballot on our website, http://vote.franklincountyohio.gov.

Election Day is Tuesday, May 6, 2025. Polls open at 6:30 a.m. and close at 7:30 p.m.
