"SECTION 11. SUCCESSION TO THE OFFICE OF MAYOR. IF THE MAYOR DIES, RESIGNS OR REMOVES HIS RESIDENCE FROM THE CITY, DURING THE TERM OF HIS OFFICE, THE PRESIDENT OF COUNCIL SHALL BE THE ACTING MAYOR UNTIL THE VACANCY IS FILLED BY THE ELECTION OF A MAYOR BY A MAJORITY VOTE OF COUNCIL.

IF THE MAYOR-ELECT SHALL DIE BEFORE ASSUMING OF-FICE, THE COUNCIL SHALL, AT ITS FIRST MEETING IN THE FOLLOWING JANUARY, ELECT A MAYOR.

THE PERSON SÓ ELECTED IN EITHER OF THE ABOVE CON-TINGENCIES SHALL POSSESS ALL THE QUALIFICATIONS REQUI-RED OF A MAYOR BY THIS CHARTER AND MAY SERVE UNTIL THE FIRST OF JANUARY FOLLOWING THE NEXT REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTION, AT WHICH ELECTION, A MAYOR SHALL BE ELECTED FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE UNEXPIRED TERM, OR FOR A FOUR YEAR TERM, AS THE CASE MAY BE.

IF THE MAYOR IS TEMPORARILY ABSENT FROM THE CITY, OR SHALL BECOME UNABLE TO PERFORM HIS DUTIES, THEY SHALL BE PERFORMED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL UN-DER THE TITLE OF ACING MAYOR, UNTIL THE MAYOR RETURNS TO THE CITY OR BECOMES ABLE TO PERFORM HIS DUTIES."

PROPOSED CHARTER AMENDMENT

CITY OF UPPER ARLINGTON

SHALL THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF UPPER ARLINGTON, OHIO, BE AMENDED AS PROPOSED BY ORDINANCE No. 64-65 OF THE CITY OF UPPER ARLINGTON BY THE AMENDMENT OF SECTION XVI THEREOF TO READ AS FOLLOWS?

SECTION XVI. THE AGGREGATE AMOUNT OF TAXES THAT MAY BE LEVIED BY THE COUNCIL WITHOUT A VOTE OF THE PEOPLE, FOR ALL MUNICIPAL PURPOSES, ON PROPERTY WHICH IS TAXABLE ACCORDING TO VALUE, SHALL NOT EXCEED 8 MILLS ON EACH DOLLAR OF TAXABLE VALUATION, PROVIDED THAT AN ADDITIONAL TAX OF 2 MILLS ON EACH DOLLAR OF TAXABLE VALUATION MAY BE LEVIED AND USED ONLY FOR THE PAYMENT OF INTEREST AND RETIREMENT CHARGES ON NOTES AND BONDS LEGALLY ISSUED. TAXES MAY BE LEVIED OUTSIDE OF THESE LIMITATIONS UPON APPROVAL BY A MAJORITY OF THE ELECTORS OF THE CITY VOTING THEREON AT A NOVEMBER ELECTION OR IN ANY MANNER PROVIDED BY GENERAL LAW FOR VOTING LEVIES OUTSIDE THE STATUTORY LIMITATIONS.

THE COUNCIL SHALL NOT ENACT ANY ORDINANCE LEVYING AN INCOME TAX EXCEPT UPON APPROVAL BY A MAJORITY OF THE ELECTORS OF THE CITY VOTING THEREON AT A GENERAL OR SPECIAL ELECTION HELD NOT LESS THAN 60 DAYS AFTER THE ADOPTION BY COUNCIL OF A RESOLUTION CALLING FOR SUCH ELECTION, WHICH RESOLUTION SHALL SET FORTH THE RATE OF THE PROPOSED TAX AND THE PURPOSES FOR WHICH THE RECEIPTS THEREFROM SHALL BE USED. IN THE EVENT OF AN AFFIRMATIVE VOTE, THE PROCEEDS OF SUCH LEVY MAY BE USED FOR THE SPECIFIED PURPOSES.
