 SECTION 1, THAT THE ZONING ORDINANCE NO. 1179 AND THE ZONING MAP WHICH IS A PART THEREOF BE AND THE SAME ARE HEREBY AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:
 THAT THE AREA HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED NOW ZONED PLANNED RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT (PRD), BE REZONED TO MULTIPLE-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL (R-4).
 BEING A 57.554 ACRE TRACT SITUATED AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE INTERSECTION OF WEST MAIN STREET AND INTERSTATE ROUTE #71, EXTENDED EASTERLY ALONG WEST MAIN STREET A DISTANCE OF 1,750 FEET, AND NORTHERLY ALONG INTERSTATE ROUTE #71 A DISTANCE OF 1,985 FEET.
 SECTION 2. THAT THE SITE PLAN OF THE PROPOSED DEVELOPMENT SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE WESTERVILLE PLANNING COMMISSION.
