REFERENDUM ON ORDINANCE NO. 1632

CITY OF WESTERVILLE

ORDINANCE NO. 1632, PASSED JUNE 17, 1969, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WESTERVILLE, OHIO: SECTION 1, THAT THE ZONING ORDINANCE NO. 1179 AND THE ZONING MAP WHICH IS A PART THEREOF BE AND THE SAME ARE HEREBY AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

THAT THE AREA HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED NOW ZONED PLANNED RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT (PRD), BE REZONED TO MULTIPLE-

FAMILY RESIDENTIAL (R-4).

BEING A 57.554 ACRE TRACT SITUATED ALTHE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE INTERSECTION OF WEST MAIN STREET AND INTERSTATE ROUTE #71, EXTENDED EASTERLY ALONG WEST MAIN STREET A DISTANCE OF 1,750 FEET, AND NORTHERLY ALONG INTERSTATE ROUTE #71 A DISTANCE OF 1,985 FEET. SECTION 2. THAT THE SITE PLAN OF THE PROPOSED DEVELOPMENT SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE WESTER-VILLE PLANNING COMMISSION.

SECTION 3. THAT ALL OTHER PROVISIONS OF SAID ORDINANCE NO. 1179 WITH ITS ACCOMPANYING MAP SHALL REMAIN IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT.

SECTION 4. THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT AND BE IN FORCE FROM AND AFTER THE EARLIEST PERIOD ALLOWED BY LAW.
