PROPOSED CHARTER AMENDMENT

CITY OF GAHANNA

SHALL THE GAHANNA CITY CHARTER BE AMENDED BY THE ADOPTION OF THE AMENDMENT PROPOSED BY ORDINANCE NO. 48-75, PASSED APRIL 1, 1975, BY REDEFINING THE DUTIES AND POWERS OF THE MAYOR AND BY CREATING THE APPOINTIVE OFFICE OF CITY ADMINISTRATOR AND DEFINING HIS DUTIES AND POWERS? THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR WILL BE THE CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER. THE AMENDMENT PROVIDES THAT THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE SHALL BE APPOINTED BY THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR AND THAT HE SHALL SERVE AS ACTING CITY ADMINISTRATOR IN THE ABSENCE OF THAT OFFICER. THE PURCHASING AGENT FUNCTION OF THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE SHALL BE REPEALED AND VESTED IN THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR. THE POWER OF THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO EMPLOY ASSISTANTS SHALL BE REPEALED. THE DIRECTOR OF PARKS AND RECREATION SHALL BE APPOINTED BY THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR AND SHALL SERVE UNDER HIS SUPERVISION AND CONTROL. THE CHANGES WILL BE EFFECTED BY THE AMENDMENT OF SECTIONS 3.04, 6.01, 6.03, 12.01 AND 12.02, BY THE ENACTMENT OF SECTIONS 3.08, 3.09 AND 3.10 AND BY THE REPEAL OF SECTIONS 6.04 AND 6.05, EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 1976.

PLAIN TOWNSHIP (UNINCORPORATED AREA)


AN AMENDMENT TO THE FRANKLIN COUNTY ZONING RESOLUTIONS AND MAPS WAS ADOPTED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS ON OCTOBER 22, 1974 IN ZONING CASE NO. 74-27, WHICH CHANGED ZONING ON A TRACT OF LAND CONTAINING APPROXIMATELY 180.027 ACRES, SITUATED ON THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF STATE ROUTE 161 AND BABBITT ROAD, FROM A RURAL DISTRICT TO A RESTRICTED SUBURBAN RESIDENTIAL (R-2) DISTRICT CONTAINING APPROXIMATELY 117 ACRES AND A LIMITED SUBURBAN (R-4) DISTRICT CONTAINING APPROXIMATELY 63 ACRES.
