 CITY OF WORTHINGTON  
 REFERENDUM ON ZONING AMENDMENT

ORDINANCE NO. 30-84, PASSED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WORTHINGTON ON JUNE 11, 1984, PROVIDES THAT THE ZONING MAP OF THE CITY OF WORTHINGTON BE AMENDED BY CHANGING THE ZONING OF CERTAIN LAND FROM R-10, LOW DENSITY RESIDENCE, TO AR-4.5, LOW DENSITY APARTMENT. THE LAND AFFECTED IS AN 8.7 ACRE VACANT TRACT GENERALLY LOCATED SOUTH OF STATE ROUTE #161, WEST OF LINWORTH ROAD, EAST OF AND ABUTTING THE CHESAPEAKE & OHIO RAILROAD TRACKS, AND NORTH OF BEECHVIEW DRIVE (EXTENDED).

SHALL ORDINANCE NO. 30-84, PASSED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WORTHINGTON TO AMEND THE OFFICIAL ZONING MAP BY CHANGING THE ZONING OF CERTAIN LAND FROM R-10, LOW DENSITY RESIDENCE, TO AR-4.5, LOW DENSITY APARTMENT, BE APPROVED.




