**PROPOSED BOND ISSUE**

**CITY OF HILLIARD**

A Majority Affirmative Vote is Necessary for Passage.

Shall bonds be issued by the City of Hilliard for the purpose of **ACQUIRING AND CONSTRUCTING A BUILDING TO HOUSE POLICE FACILITIES FOR THE CITY OF HILLIARD, OHIO, FURNISHING AND EQUIPPING THE SAME, AND ACQUIRING RELATED APPURTENANCES THEREFOR** in the principal amount of \$3,500,000 to be repaid annually over a maximum period of twenty-five (25) years, and an annual levy of property taxes be made outside the ten-mill limitation, estimated by the County Auditor to average over the repayment period of the bond issue one and two-tenths (1.2) mills for each one dollar of tax valuation, which amounts to twelve cents (\$0.12) for each one hundred dollars of tax valuation, to pay the annual debt charges on the bonds, and to pay debt charges on any notes issued in anticipation of those bonds.

**PROPOSED TAX LEVY  
(REPLACEMENT AND INCREASE)  
MADISON PLAINS LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICT**  
A Majority Affirmative Vote is Necessary for Passage

A replacement of two and one-half (2½) mills and an increase of one (1.0) mill to constitute a tax for the benefit of the Madison Plains Local School District, Fayette, Franklin and Madison Counties, Ohio, for the purpose of **REPAIRING, RENOVATING, REMODELING, CONSTRUCTING, AND IMPROVING BUILDINGS FOR SCHOOL PURPOSES, FURNISHING AND EQUIPPING SCHOOL BUILDINGS, IMPROVING SCHOOL GROUNDS AND ACQUIRING SCHOOL BUSES OF THE MADISON PLAINS LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICT**, at a rate not exceeding three and one-half (3½) mills for each one dollar (\$1.00) of valuation, which amounts to thirty-five cents (\$0.35) for each one hundred dollars (\$100.00) of valuation for five (5) years.
