Shall the sale of beer and intoxicating liquor be permitted on Sunday by Vittorio Investments, Inc., doing business at Champions Municipal Golf Course, an applicant for a D-6 liquor permit, who is engaged in the business of catering and operating the food and beverage service at Champions Golf Course at 3900 Westerville Road, Columbus, Ohio 43224 in this precinct?

A Majority Affirmative Vote is Necessary for Passage.

COLUMBUS AND FRANKLIN COUNTY METRO PARKS TAX LEVY (Repl & Incr) (ISSUE #15)

A Majority Affirmative Vote is Necessary for Passage.

A replacement of 0.55 mill of an existing levy and an increase of 0.1 mill to constitute a tax for the benefit of the Columbus and Franklin County Metropolitan Park District (commonly known as Metro Parks) for the purpose of CONSERVING NATURAL RESOURCES; DEVELOPING IMPROVING, MAINTAINING, AND OPERATING BLACKLICK WOODS, SHARON WOODS, BLENDON WOODS, HIGHBANKS, BATTELLE-DARBY CREEK, PICKERINGTON PONDS, CHESTNUT RIDGE, SLATE RUN, CLEAR CREEK, THREE CREEKS METRO PARKS, INNISWOOD METRO GARDENS AND OTHER PROPERTIES OF THE PARK DISTRICT; AND ACQUIRING, DEVELOPING, IMPROVING, MAINTAINING, AND OPERATING ADDITIONAL LANDS FOR PARK PURPOSES at a rate not exceeding 0.65 mill for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$0.065 for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for a period of ten (10) years, commencing 1999 tax year.

CITY OF BEXLEY PROPOSED CHARTER AMENDMENT (ISSUE #17)

A Majority Affirmative Vote is Necessary for Passage.

Shall the amendments to the Bexley City Charter proposing to change the form of government from the Council-Mayor plan to the Council-City Manager plan, by replacing an elected Mayor as the City's chief executive officer with a City Manager appointed by Council and an elected Auditor as the City's chief financial officer with a Finance Director appointed by the City Manager, with the concurrence of Council, be adopted? If the amendments are adopted, the Mayor/City Manager change would be effective January 1, 2000, and the Auditor/Finance Director change would be effective January 1, 2002.

receiving a majority vote but not the required
three-fourths affirmative vote shall become
effective as non-emergency legislation.

of this amendment shall be terminated by the
Village pursuant to the terms of those contracts, if

Issue bonds for the purposed of ACQUIRING REAL ESTATE FOR SCHOOL BUILDINGS, CONSTRUCTING A NEW ELEMENTARY SCHOOL AND A NEW MIDDLE SCHOOL, WITH RELATED FURNISHINGS, EQUIPMENT, AND SITE IMPROVEMENTS in the principal amount of \$27,100,000, to be repaid annually over a maximum period of 28 years, and levy a property tax outside the ten-mill limitation, estimated by the county auditor to average over the bond repayment period 1.69 mills for each one dollar of tax valuation, which amounts to \$0.169 for each one hundred dollars of tax valuation, to pay the annual debt charges on the bonds, and to pay debt charges on any notes issued in anticipation of those bonds?

2. Levy an additional property tax to pay CURRENT OPERATING EXPENSES at a rate not exceeding 7.2 mills for each one dollar of tax valuation, which amounts to \$0.72 for each one hundred dollars of tax valuation, for a continuing period of time?

Shall bonds be issued by the Teays Valley Local School District for the purpose of CONSTRUCTING ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS AT WALNUT AND SCIOTO; TO CONSTRUCT A CAFETERIA AND LIBRARY AT ASHVILLE ELEMENTARY; TO CONSTRUCT A CAFETERIA, MUSIC FACILITY, AND CLASSROOMS AT THE MIDDLE SCHOOL; TO CONSTRUCT A VOCATIONAL FACILITY AT THE HIGH SCHOOL; TO PURCHASE EQUIPMENT AND APPURTENANCES; AND TO RENOVATE ELEMENTARY, MIDDLE SCHOOL AND HIGH SCHOOL FACILITIES in the principal amount of \$23,281,920 to be repaid annually over a maximum period of twenty-eight (28) years, and an annual levy of property taxes be made outside the ten mill limitation, estimated by the county auditor to average over the repayment period of the bond issue 6.7 mills for each one dollar of tax valuation, which amounts to \$0.67 for each one hundred dollars of tax valuation, to pay the annual debt charges on the bonds, and to pay debt charges on any notes issued in anticipation of those bonds commencing with the 1999 tax year?
