NOTICE OF GENERAL ELECTION

OHIO REVISED CODE § 3501.03

The Board of Elections of Franklin County, Ohio, issues this Proclamation and Notice of Election.

A GENERAL ELECTION WILL BE HELD on Tuesday, the 7th day of November, 2017, at the usual places of holding elections in this County or at such places as the Board may designate, for the purpose of electing candidates for the following offices:


Judges of the Franklin County Municipal Court (3 full term and 1 unexpired term), Clerk of the Franklin County Municipal Court; City Offices – Mayor (where applicable), City Attorney (where applicable), City Auditor (where applicable), and Members of Council; Village Offices – Mayor (where applicable), Clerk/Treasurer (where applicable), Members of Council, Member of Trustees of Board of Public Affairs (Village of Urbancrest); Township Fiscal Officer (unexpired term ending 3/31/20 in Madison); Township Trustee (2 positions - all districts; Members of Governing Boards of Educational Service Centers, Members of Boards of Education.

And for the purpose of deciding the following questions and issues:

State of Ohio – 1 Proposed Constitutional Amendment, 1 Proposed Law; Franklin County – Proposed Renewal Levy for the Board of Developmental Disabilities; City of Grove City – 5 Proposed Charter Amendments; City of Reynoldsburg – 5 Proposed Charter Amendments; Village of Minerva Park – Referendum of Resolution; Village of Valleyview – Proposed Tax Levy (additional); Franklin Township (unincorporated area) – Proposed Home Rule Government; Jefferson Township – Fire Levy (renewal); Mifflin Township (unincorporated area) – Police Levy (replacement and increase); Sharon Township (unincorporated area) – Policy Levy (additional); New Albany Plain Local School District – Proposed Tax Levy (additional); Upper Arlington City School District – Proposed Bond and Levy (additional); Delaware Area Career Center - Proposed Tax Levy (renewal); Madison-Plains Local School District – Proposed Tax Levy (renewal)
