Notice is hereby given that in pursuance of a Resolution of the Board of Trustees

 passed on the 21 day of November, 2019, there will be submitted to a vote of the people at the

 (Primary, General or Special) Election to be held at the regular places of voting on  
Tuesday, the 17 day of March, 2020 the question of issuing bonds in the principal amount of  
three hundred million dollars (\$ 300,000,000 ) for the purpose of  
all or a part of the cost of purchasing sites in Franklin County; for the erection, furnishings, and equipment of buildings in Franklin County,  
including technology; and for the acquisition or construction of any property in Franklin County which the board of trustees of a state community  
college is authorized to acquire or construct, including renovations and improvements for workforce development and safety and security

The maximum number of years over which the principal of the bonds may be paid is 24 years.  
 The estimated additional average annual property tax levy amounts to \$0.065  
 \_\_\_\_\_  
 (Rate expressed in cents or dollars and cents)  
 for each one hundred dollars of tax valuation, which is 0.65 mills for each one dollar of tax  
 valuation, in excess of the tax limitation as estimated and certified by the County Auditor. The first calendar  
 year in which the tax is expected to be due is 2021

The polls for the election will be open at 6:30 a.m. and remain open until 7:30 p.m. on election day.
