## Notice of Election on Issue of Bonds

Notice is hereby given that in pursuance of a Resolution of the City Council of the City of Columbus, Ohio, passed on the 18th day of July, 2022, there will be submitted to a vote of the people at the General Election to be held at the regular places of voting on Tuesday, the 8th day of November, 2022 the question of issuing bonds in the principal amount of two hundred million dollars (\$200,000,000) for the purpose of promoting neighborhood and community development and affordable housing within the City of Columbus by purchasing, constructing, demolishing, renovating, improving, equipping and furnishing residential and commercial structures in the City, and acquiring, clearing, testing, remediating environmental issues, extending utilities, and otherwise improving residential and commercial sites in the City, and providing funds for grants in connection with the same.

The maximum number of years over which the principal of the bonds may be paid is 20 years. The estimated additional average annual property tax levy amounts to \$0.078 for each one hundred dollars of tax valuation, which is 0.78 mill for each one dollar of tax valuation, in excess of the tax limitation as estimated and certified by the County Auditor. The first calendar year in which the tax is expected to be due is 2023.

The polls for the election will be open at 6:30 a.m. and remain open until 7:30 p.m. on election day.
