Largest One Day Total Yet for Primary Election Absentee Voting

(Columbus) The Franklin County Board of Elections saw its largest one day total yet for absentee voting for the 2012 primary election on Saturday. The numbers show 162 voting in-person at the board of elections when polls opened from 8:00 a.m. to noon.

Early voting resumed at the board this morning and will end this week. Voting is scheduled from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. through Thursday and from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Friday, March 2- the last day of the absentee voting period.

The Franklin County Board of Elections is located at 280 East Broad Street, Columbus.

A total of 25, 786 had requested absentee ballots in person and by mail as of 8:00 a.m. today. Applications are available online at <http://vote.franklincountyohio.gov> or by calling the board of elections at (614) 525-3100.
