Southeast Apostolic Mission New Voting Location for Two Columbus Precincts

(Columbus) The Franklin County Board of Elections reminds voters in two precincts in southeast Columbus that they will be voting at a new location on Election Day, Nov. 6.

The polling place for voters in precincts 3-B and 51- D has moved from the former Canaan Baptist Church at 1428 Fairwood Avenue to the **Southeast Apostolic Mission at 1505 East Deshler Avenue.**

The new voting location is near the intersection of Fairwood and Deshler and a short distance to the north of the previous location which recently became unavailable for this election. Signs will be posted at each location so that voters can find their new polling place on Election Day.

Approximately 978 voters in precinct 3-B and 1,119 voters in precinct 51-D are impacted by this change and were recently notified of the move in a mailing by the board of elections.
