More than 200,000 Voters Update Registration in Franklin County

(Columbus) The Franklin County Board of Elections has completed its latest effort to keep voter registration records up to date under the National Voter Registration Act better known as the Motor Voter law.

Figures released today show 201,853 voters contacted by mail beginning in 2011 have opted to remain registered while another 43,451 will have their registrations purged because they did not respond to the mailing within the four year period as the law demands.

Motor Voter mailings are conducted annually. Letters are sent to voters who haven't voted in two years or because postal records show they've moved in that time without updating their voting address. Those purged today either not voted or updated their registered address since 2009.

Voters have until Feb. 15 to register for the 2016 primary. Our Web site has two links to help them. Registration forms are available at <http://vote.franklincountyohio.gov>.
