## Franklin County Board of Elections Joins America 250-Ohio to Commemorate America's 250<sup>th</sup> Anniversary

(**Columbus**) The Franklin County Board of Elections is pleased to announce its official designation as a proud participant in the statewide America 250-Ohio initiative, the celebration of the United States' 250th anniversary in 2026. The full resolution unanimously approved by our board is included at the conclusion of this release.

Under the leadership of the Ohio Commission for the U.S. semiquincentennial, America 250-Ohio is encouraging communities across all 88 Ohio counties to highlight their unique contributions to the American story—past, present, and future.

As a member, the Board joins a growing network of local governments, non-profits, civic organizations, and county entities that are committed to commemorating this once-in-a-generation milestone.

Ohio and its counties including Franklin have played significant roles in shaping the nation—from early settlement and frontier politics to innovations in industry, governance, education, and civic life. America 250-Ohio aims to give voice to those stories and create a framework through which local communities can engage.

By participating, the Franklin County Board of Elections underscores its dedication to civic engagement, inclusive democracy, and public service—linking the Board's everyday work of elections administration with the broader themes of citizenship and community that America 250-Ohio emphasizes.

The Mission of the Franklin County Board of Elections is to provide election services, information and education to the residents of Franklin County so they can exercise their right to vote and have confidence that elections are fair, impartial, and accurate. There are many things to administering elections in Ohio's largest county. They include registering citizens to vote as well as maintaining our voter registration database which at the time of this release stands at almost 900,000 voters. Recruiting and training upwards of 5,000 poll workers that work at nearly 300 Election Day voting locations, and the absentee component which deals with mail-in ballots and in-person voting done all before Election Day. Voting is a lynchpin of the American experience of self-governance and is what makes our Country unique and should be celebrated.

"We are honored to join America 250-Ohio and contribute our voice and story to this statewide celebration," said Douglas Preisse, Chairman of the Franklin County Board of Elections and Commission Co-Chair America 250-Ohio. "This designation reinforces our commitment to preserving how democracy works here at home, while connecting our local efforts to Ohio's—and America's—larger narrative."
