

Notice is hereby given that in pursuance of a Resolution of the City Council of City of Upper Arlington, Ohio, passed on the 15th day of June, 2026, there will be submitted to a vote of the people at the General Election to be held at the regular places of voting on Tuesday, the 3rd day of November, 2026, the question of levying a tax, in excess of the ten mill limitation, which shall be a renewal of a tax of 0.89 mills and an increase of 0.24 mills for each \$1 of taxable value to constitute a tax for the benefit of the City of Upper Arlington for the purpose of paying the City's employer contributions to the Ohio Police and Fire Pension Fund at a rate not exceeding 1.13 mills for each \$1 of taxable value, which amounts to \$26 for each \$100,000 of the county auditor's market value, for 5 years.

The estimated annual collections of this levy is \$2,190,393.

The polls for the election will be open at 6:30 a.m. and remain open until 7:30 p.m. on election day.
