Franklin County Voting Location Notifications Mailed for General Election

(Columbus) Postcard notification notices are in the mail and heading to 445,119 Franklin County households. This mailing is to remind voters of their polling location where they will cast their vote on November 8 if they have not already requested an absentee ballot. Households with multiple registered voters will receive one postcard.

The Board of Elections is also sending an additional postcard out to 45,175 registered voters notifying them of a polling location change.

A number of voters might be confused as to why they are receiving another notice after they just received a notice in August. These voters received a temporary change notice in August because of a Special Election and are now being reassigned back to their previous location.

Each postcard lists the name, address and precinct of the new voting location. Voting locations are also available under the sample ballot link on our website www.vote.franklincountyohio.gov

Voters must be registered by October 11 to be eligible for this election.
